

EXAMPLES OF STUDENT VOLUNTEER ASSIGNMENTS

(YOU ARE NOT LIMITED TO THESE)

Big Buddies: Act as "big buddies" to children who need support and guidance.

Blood Bank: Register donors and provide refreshments after donations are made.

Child care: Care for children in non-profit day care centers, latchkey programs, preschools, and shelters.

Clothes Collection: Collect clothes, food, toys, and other goods for food pantries and other organizations.

Community History: Research oral history or become involved in other local history projects.

Cook Meals: Assist with meal preparation at soup kitchens or community fundraisers.

Crisis Centers: Provide support for staff.

Emergency Services: With appropriate training, serve on First Aid Squads, Fire Departments, or Police Departments.

Environmental Cleanup: Clean up parks, beaches, and otherwise beautify the environment.

Environmental Research: Assist environmental groups and government agencies with conservation and public awareness projects.

Fundraising: Raise funds for charities, service projects, or needed equipment.

Hospitals: Visit patients, distribute magazines, brighten holidays for hospitalized adults and children.

Jewish Family Services: Prepare or distribute food baskets, help senior adults.

Jewish Federation: Work at Super Sunday to help in major fundraising efforts to support the community.

Libraries: Shelve books, assist with special programs or events.

Nursing Homes: Visit patients, help with special programs.

Senior Housing: Help with activities or assist with holiday events.
