DRESS REHEARSAL CHECKLIST

Morning Service

Please be sure to bring these things with you for your Dress Rehearsal:

1. All of your papers and books. Be sure your *siddur* has your name on the front and back cover. *Bring everything, even if you think you don't need it.*
2. The full-page printout of the photo of your Torah portion.
3. The final copy of your sermon *fastened with paperclip, not stapled*. Be sure to number the pages.
4. The following lists of names:
 - a) One, two or three people for the English reading in the service.
 - b) Torah service honors:
1 or 2 people to open the ark, 1 person to undress the Torah, 1 person to dress the Torah, and 1 person to hold the Torah.
 - c) English **and Jewish names for *aliyot***, including the father's and mother's Jewish names of each person doing an *aliyah*. Rabbi Weber gave you a sheet with all the information you need to assign *aliyot*.
 - d) Names of the Bar/Bat Mitzvah's friends, who will sing *Al Shelosha Devarim*. (Up to 6, plus any members of his/her religious school class)
 - e) Up to six people (in addition to your immediate family) for *kiddush*.
 - f) Up to 15 names of those who have died, for *kaddish*.
5. Completed copies of "Blessing for your relative" for each person giving a blessing.
6. The photographer's letter, if not already submitted.
